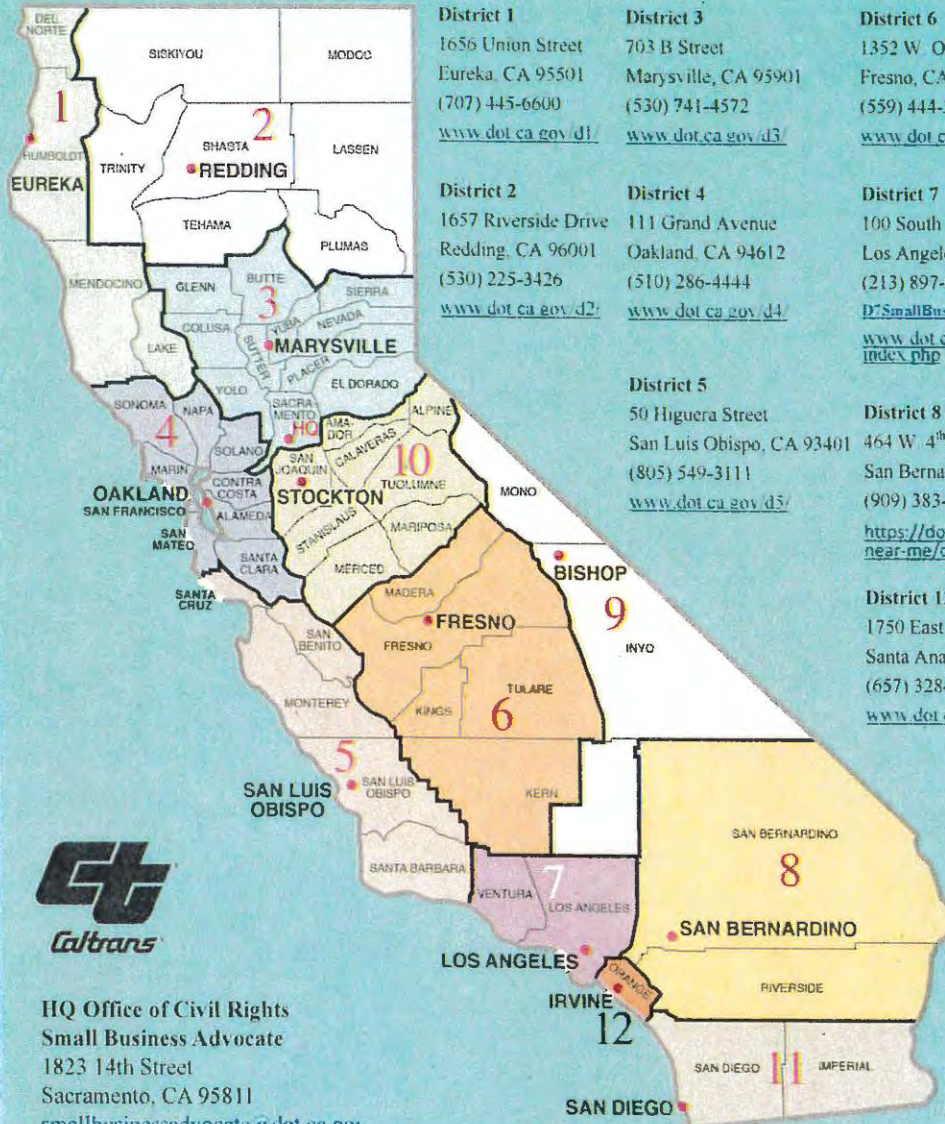

SUPPORTIVE SERVICES

Caltrans is committed to increasing the total number of certified DBE firms active in the federal-aid highway construction and professional services industries, and contributing to their growth and eventual self-sufficiency. To this end, Disadvantaged Business Enterprise/Supportive Services (DBE/SS) are offered by Caltrans on a contract basis, at no cost, to DBEs and potential DBEs.

Supportive services include:

- Enrollment in a Business Development Program to improve business planning and management skills
- Assistance navigating Caltrans contracting opportunities
- Technical assistance
- DBE certification application assistance (for potential DBEs)
